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## 1) Report of Workshop on Freshwater Ornamental Fish Rearing

The programme began with Tilawate-E-Quran – recitations from Holy Quran by junior college supervisor Prof Alam Nadvi. The welcome address was given by Dr. Capt Akbar Dalvi followed by Principal's address byDr. Sirajuddin Chougle. 



Hence, the main objective of the workshop was to provide introduction to Internet of Things (IoT), to give exposure to various sub-fields and technology stacks of IoT and to enable people to convert their IoT product idea into a working prototype. To fulfil the gap between industry and academia and the department had planned this hand on sessions in collaboration with Edkits. According to the statistics it is estimated that by 2020 the market cap of IOT would be around 1.7 Trillion dollars. It is no secret that India is an emerging player in the communications industry with the tenfold increase in mobile phones and electronics usages in last few years. As per LinkedIn, IOT will be most sort after skills by 2021. Total 80 students have participated in this workshop. During this session students had an exposure to various contents relating to IoT. They were taught about architecture and cloud services and data analytics and students were made aware about various protocols, raspberry pi, security features of IoT, hands on sessions and troubleshooting of problems.

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### 6) Report on Workshop on Mapping Technology

A workshop on Mapping Technology was conducted by the Departments of Computer Science and Information Technology on the 9th of March 2018 in collaboration with HereMaps. Mr Afraz Shaikh Director Gobiz Lab was the resource persons for this workshop. The workshop started with the introduction of the Resource Person and later Mr Arfaz introduced key concepts on mapping; defining critical terms, capabilities as well as current limitations of mapping tools. The sessions also included multimedia resources to better elucidate key concepts. The key concepts were introduced from the absolute basics as this workshop was designed to cater to participants of F.Y class with any skill level in coding. Multiple simplified examples and use case was explained. The students showed keen interest in the workshop and have gained a hands-on experience in the topics of mapping and dataset. Overall 50 students and 4 faculty members participated from the departments. This workshop was a good learning experience for the participants. The workshop that was sponsored by Fly High Aviation Academy and Master Skills Hub, had eminent physicist Dr. Sunil Mukhi, Prof. Sunil Mukhi, Ph.d scholar in Theoretical Physics from Stony Brook University, Chair of the Science Programme, IISER Pune, a Fellow of IAS, INSA and The World Academy of Sciences and recipient of Shanti Swarup Bhatnagar Prize in Physical Sciences in 1999 and Dr Jaydeep Sarangi, an experienced, well known author, critic and editor of innumerable books as it's keynote speaker and resource persons. It was graced by the principal of the college, Dr. Sirajuddin Chougle, who emphasised on the significance of professional ethics in the teaching community for developing a viable teaching-learning and research atmosphere. Prof Dr. Sunil Mukhi, who also holds an important position in the Academic Ethics Council, IISER, Pune, observed, "Ethical consciousness and high Professional competencies are the basis of the profession's integrity and are essential in creating good conditions for learning and teaching environment." The workshop co ordinator, Ms Mayurakshi Mitra, in her welcome speech, appreciating the efforts of the principal Dr.Sirajuddin Chougle and IQAC Cordinator Dr. Rakhshandah Hani for selecting a critical but often neglected area of concern as the workshop theme, highlighted the need of maintaining long term individual and social gains in maintaining ethical practices and therefore the significance of Professional Ethics. The sessions that were highly interactive, interesting, and motivating were successful in driving home the significance of having and maintaining academic ethics and original research work for a better teaching learning experience and thereby bridge the gap between copied and original research work.
