

Provide necessary help and collaboration wherever possible in organizing conferences/ c) seminars/ workshops/ and personality development/ life skill training programmes between Institutes for enhancement of skills in respect of staff and students.

Jointly organizing webinars, conferences and training workshops. d)

Usage of academic infrastructure of both Institutes by students and faculty members e) wherever and whenever possible.

Arranging talks, webinars on personality development, soft skills, tourism etc for 1) students of both Institutes especially MCACS event on 'Konkan Safari'

- Cooperate in activities of mutual interest especially in activities related to NCC, NSS g) and DLLE
- To facilitate training sessions for teachers and students whenever possible h)

7. Coordinators:



MOU/ Expression of Interest

- This Memorandum of Understanding is being executed on 23/07/2018 between M/s ATS InfoTech Pvt.Ltd. A Microsoft-AEP (Authorized Education Partner) having its registered office at L-107, Lajpat Nagar-II, New Delhi -110024 and represented by Mr. Sandeep Giyyan JJethani (Director Operations) hence for purpose of MOU known as 'Delivery Partner' and Maharashtra College Of Arts, Science and Commerce, represented by Dr.Sirajuddin Chougle hence for purpose of MOU known as 'Resource Partner'.
- 2. Delivery Partner would be offering International Certifications to the interested students from different vendors @ academic discounted price and those students who voluntarily pay the exam fees would be getting bundled training free of cost mapped to the certifications.
- 3. This contract in no way creates any financial binding nor does it imply that 'resource partner' has committed to provide any fixed number of student's registrations per year for the certification exams /bundled workshops, the only commitment from their end is to provide platform to address students / seminar to educate and motivate them about the various certifications and subsequent permission for registering the students who are voluntarily interested in the same.
- 4. As part of the special offering all exam vouchers provided to the students for certifications would have a **second attempt bundled free** in case the student fails to clear the same in first attempt.
- 5. Delivery Partner would bundle a **'free of charge'** faculty development Program once a year for the faculty members of the **resource partner**.
- 6. Delivery Partner would also **sponsor certification vouchers for faculty members** equivalent to 10% of the total students enrolled in academic year.
- 7. Students would be registering directly for the certification exam by making payment to the SPOC appointed by the **resource partner** or with M/s ATS Infotech Pvt Ltd. either online or offline by chq/cash/DD. Proper receipts would be issued for the same. Incase if only the **resource partner** collects the payments, the same would have to be transferred to **delivery partner** max within 7 days, as exam vouchers can only be registered once payment is made. Students would be receiving a conformation mail of their voucher being booked and entitlement to free training/workshop, once they register either online or offline.
- 8. The fee charged is against Microsoft /other vendor Certification exam and all other services like training are complimentary / bundled free and cannot be linked anywhere with the release of payment to **delivery partner** (in case if the certification fees is collected by **resource partner**).

- 9. Student would be receiving their **transcript and certificates** for the exam directly in their account in e-format, from the specific vendor like Microsoft /Oracle/Certiport etc. post successfully clearing the exam.
- 10. Resource Partner would be Provided 15% 'Resource Utilization Fees' against use of infrastructure and other resources for the bundled free training. The Resource Utilization fees will be paid on basic fee excluding the taxes.
- 11. Resource Partner would provide necessary infrastructure within college, like labs with Computers, LCD Projector's, internet etc. for the execution of the **free training** and conducting the **Certification Exam.**
- 12. Resource partner would allocate time slot either on weekends/holidays /regular slot for min 6-8hrs or as per mutual consent with delivery partner for execution of FREE training in their campus.
- 13. The duration of the training may increase as per the level of participants and shall not be linked with the release of payments.
- 14. The tenure of the contract would be for a period of three years i.e. from 23/07/2018 to 22/03/2021, same cannot be terminated for min period of one year from the date of signing of the MOU.
- 15. Prices of the certification are subject to yearly review and revision as per the policy of the Certification vendor and other state and govt taxes as and when applicable by the Govt of India. However, a proper communication would be provided, whenever there is impact on the same.
- 16. "Resource Partner" cannot hire or take services from any current full time /part time, exemployee of the Delivery Partner either directly or indirectly for any fulltime or part time assignment for minimum period of one year from the date of expiry of contract.
- 17. **"Resource Partner"** must follow from time to time rules/regulation & operational protocols laid down by Microsoft/Certiport other international vendors for their respective certification.
- 18. In case of any dispute, or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of or relating to the construction, meaning, scope, operation or effect of this contract or the validity or the breach there of shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Arbitration of the Indian Council of Arbitration and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties "however the court of jurisdiction would be New Delhi.
- 19. This clause is intended to be legally binding and the parties agree and acknowledge that both the terms of this MOU and the discussions relating to the collaborative activity are confidential and neither party will disclose them without the prior written consent of the other party.
- 20. **Resource Partner** would issue a letter of completion upon successful completion of the certification and bundled training program.
- 21. Minimum batch size to run a free training/workshop bundled with Certification will be 50 students however in case the numbers are very less than the decision on the same would be as per mutual consent.

COMMUNITY AGREEMENT BETWEEN

HERE SOLUTIONS INDIA PRIVATE LIMITED AND MAHARASHTRA COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE AND COMMERCE

This Community Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into as of 13.05.2018 ("Effective Date") by HERE Solutions India Private Limited (including its affiliated companies), with registered head office at Unit No. 305-308 (AC Units), 3rd Floor, Multistoried Building, SEEP2, MIDC, Andheri (East), Mumbai – 400 096 ("HERE") and Maharashtra College of Arts, Science and Commerce, 246-A, J.B.B-Marg, Mumbai-400008.

A. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Agreement is to allow HERE and Partner (later referred to as "Party" or "Parties", as applicable) to collaborate in HERE's community expert program through the HERE Map Creator tool ("Purpose"). The objective of this project is to jointly verify, improve and maintain the freshness of the HERE map data though the HERE Map Creator tool based on a collaboration framework ensuring educational, cultural and technological exchange. All further Partner interests shall be described in more detail in the Appendix of this agreement.

B. TERM

The Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date. This Agreement shall be in full force and effect for a twenty-four (24) months period from the Effective Date.

C. COMMITMENTS

The Parties agree to perform necessary actions, in order to reach the Purpose of the Agreement. The details of the participation are defined in detail in "Agreedix 1 – Project Plan". Partner agrees to accept standard terms and conditions of HERE in order to access necessary Tools (as defined below) needed for fulfillment of the Purpose of this Agreement.

D. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- PARTICIPATION IN SIMILAR ACTIVITIES. This Agreement is no way restricts HERE or Partner from participating in similar activities with any other entities, such as, but not limited to, other public or private agencies, organizations, and individuals.
- 2. PROPRIETARY RIGHTS. HERE owns, or has a license to, all the rights, titles and interest, including intellectual property rights, in and to all data, content, products and/or services, including without limitation Community Map Creator tool ("Tools"), provided in any form and at any moment to Partner by, or on behalf of, HERE. Partner agrees to use the Tools only for the Purpose and in accordance with the terms, and updates to terms, provided to Partner from time to time. Any copies which Partner is permitted to make of the Tools pursuant to this Agreement must contain the same copyright and other proprietary notices that appear on the Tools.
- CONFIDENTIALITY. All communications, information exchange and personal data (such as email adresses or user statistics) shall be treaded confidentially and shall not be shared, or distributed to, third parties without prior written consent.

4. LIMITATION ON LIABILITY.

- a. NEITHER PARTY IS LIABLE TO THE OTHER IN CONTRACT, TORT OR OTHERWISE, WHATEVER THE CAUSE, FOR ANY LOSS OF PROFIT, BUSINESS OR GOODWILL OR ANY INDIRECT, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL OR PUNITIVE COST, DAMAGES OR EXPENSE OF ANY KIND, ARISING UNDER OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT.
- The foregoing limitation on liability does not apply in cases of intentional or reckless misconduct by either Party, fraud or personal injury.
- c. Neither Party shall be liable to the other for a failure to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, provided such Party notifies the other of the delay.
- 5. ASSIGNMENT. HERE may assign this Agreement, including its rights and obligations under this Agreement, to any of the HERE Affiliates. HERE Affiliates shall hereby be defined as HERE International B.V. and any entity that directly or indirectly is controlled by HERE International B.V. Additionally, HERE may assign its rights and obligations under this Agreement to a third party in connection with a merger, acquisition, sale of assets, by operation of law or otherwise. Assignment by Partner is possible only per prior written consent of HERE. For purposes of this Section, a charge in control of Partner shall be regarded as an assignment.
- WAIVER OR CHANGE. No waiver or change to the Agreement will be deemed effective unless set forth in writing and stigned by the Party charged with such waiver or change, and no waiver of any right arising from any breach will be deemed to be a waiver or authorization of any other breach of any other right arising under this Agreement.
- 7. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions hereof shall be unaffected thereby and remain valid and enforceable as if such provision had not been set forth herein. The Parties agree to substitute for such provision a valid provision that most closely approximates the intent of such severed provision.

- 8. GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTES RESOLUTION. This Agreement shall be construed and governed by the substantive laws of India without giving effect to the conflict of law provisions. The United Nations Convention of Contracts for the International Sale of Goods shall not apply to this Agreement. In the event that there is a dispute between the parties as to matters covered by this Agreement, or the validity, enforceability or interpretation thereof (each, a "Dispute"); such Dispute shall be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent court in Mumbai, India.
- 9. NOTICES. Any notice given by one Party to the other Party shall be deemed properly given if specifically acknowledged by the receiving Party in writing or when delivered to the recipient by hand or special courier during normal business hours to the following addresses (or such other address as may be notified in writing from time to time by either Party):

Notices shall be deemed to be received on the first business day following receipt. Each communication and document made or delivered by one Party to the other Party pursuant to this Agreement shall be in the English language.

- 10. <u>RELATIONSHIP</u>. This Agreement is between HERE and Partner. No third party beneficiaries are intended. In connection with this Agreement each Party is an independent contractor and as such does not have any authority to binst or commit the other. Nothing herein shall be deemed or construed to create a joint venture, partnership or agency relationship between the parties for any purpose.
- 11. COMMUNICATIONS, All media releases, public announcements and public disclosures relating to the terms or existence of this Agreement or the collaboration must be submitted by the Partner to HERE for approval prior to their release, unless the disclosure is required by applicable law, provided that in the case of required legal disclosure, Partner will provide to HERE prompt notice of such required disclosure and comply with any protective order imposed on such disclosure. HERE shall have the right to disclose the terms or existence of this Agreement or collaboration with the public through media releases and public announcements.
- 12. ORDER OF APPLICABILITY. In case this Agroement is drafted bilingually and any wording conflict arises, the English version will prevail upon the other language. In case of discrepancy between this Agreement and any other terms, including the terms applicable to the tools accessible by Partner ("Alternative Terms"), such Alternative Terms shall prevail upon this Agreement.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

KIRTI M.DOONGURSEE COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE & COMMERCE.

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU) is entered into on Tuesday, 6th July 2021 by and between MAHARSHI DAYANAND COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE & COMMERCE, MAHARASHTRA COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE & COMMERCE and KIRTI M. DOONGURSEE COLLEGE OF ARTS, SCIENCE & COMMERCE, from Mumbai and affiliated to University of Mumbai.

The aforesaid Institutes are hereinafter referred to individually as Institute and collectively as Institutes.

Purpose:

The MoU sets the terms and understanding between the three Institutes in order to undertake programmes that will encourage students of Mathematics

- to create a quest for knowledge in Mathematics
- · to be able to think critically
- · to put across their ideas effectively in problem solving
- · to develop an interest for research

Objectives of MoU:

- To promote and enhance mutual cooperation of Academic Interest between these Institutes.
- To establish faculty and student exchange programmes between these Institutes
- To provide technical assistance for enhancement of quality of education at these institutes including usage of ICT facilities.
- d) To promote research/continuing education, curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities between Institutes.

Technical areas of collaboration:

- Provide academic interaction by delivering special lectures at these Institutes on relevant topics.
- b) Provide necessary help and collaborations wherever applicable in organizing conferences / seminars / workshops / and personality development / life skill programmes / FDP between Institutes for enhancement of skills for staff and students.
- c) Cooperate in activities such as placements, Job-Mela programmes, etc.
- d) Mutual co-operation between IQACs of the Institutes.

Proposed modes of collaboration:

The Institutes propose to collaborate through the following:

- Co-operation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interests and any other appropriate mode of interaction beneficial to the institutes.
- A specific plan where needed and necessary will be worked out by the Institutes depending upon requirements and availability of resources.

Terms and Conditions:

- a) This MoU is not a commitment of funds. But all the institutes will singularly or jointly source funds based on their strengths, technical preparedness and legalities involved.
- For visits related to advice and consultancy, travel and other expenses will be borne by institutes equally.
- c) The faculty members and students can use the library facility and exchange the interest for the same.
- d) The Institutes agree to help, identify and invite faculty members and researchers from other Institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses and as advisory/organizing committee members.
- e) To give preference to staff and student participants of the Institutes
- f) This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the Institutes at any time.
- g) Either institute shall have the right to terminate this MoU upon 30 days prior written notice to the other institute.
- On mutual consent of all the Institutes, review meetings will be conducted once in three months with Co-coordinators and Principals.

Confidentiality:

The Institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the Institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either Institute or created during the period of the MoU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other Institute.

The above confidential clause under this MoU excludes the information/data possessed by either Institute before entering into the MoU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

Duration of MoU:

This MoU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the Institutes, shall expire in <u>Two</u> years after the effective data specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MoU shall be extended for another <u>Two</u> years by mutual consent.

Co-ordinators:

The Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibility for co-ordination and implementation of this agreement.

Intellectual Property Rights:

The Intellectual Property Rights(IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two Institutes.

Signed in Triplicate:

This MoU is executed in triplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal validity. By signing below, the Institutes, acting by their duty authorized officers, have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed, effective as of the day and year first above written.



- 5.1.3. Upon either Party merging with or becoming controlled directly or indirectly by any company or entity not agreeable with the other.

6. ARBITRATION:

Any dispute or differences, which may arise out of this MOU or in the institution there are, included any dispute relating to its validity or effect shall be settled under the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996.
