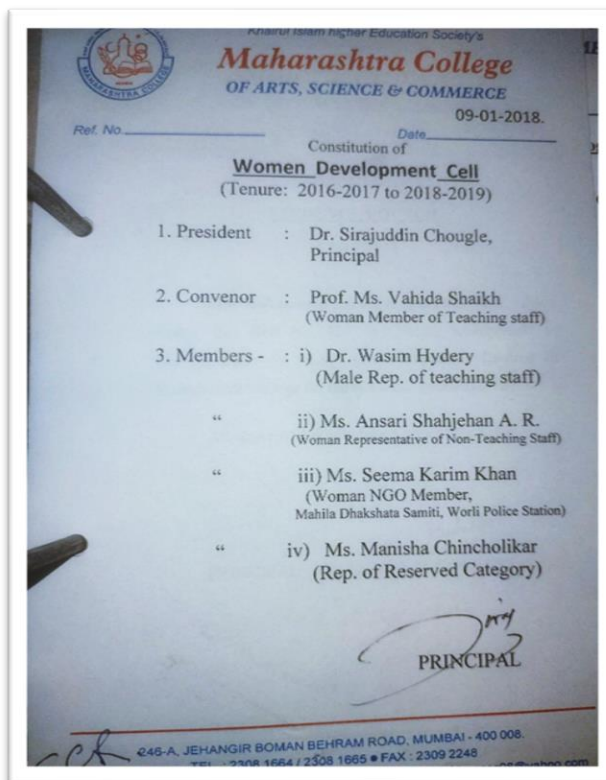

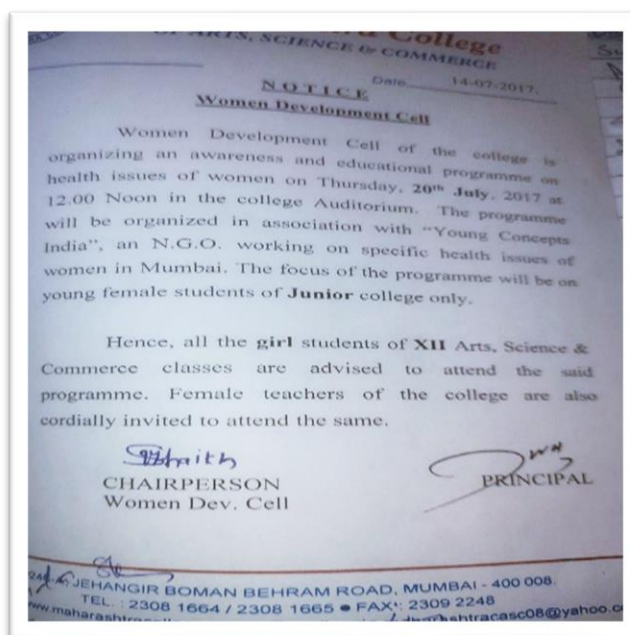
## 2) WDC reports and the gender equity programmes carried out in last five years (2017-2022)

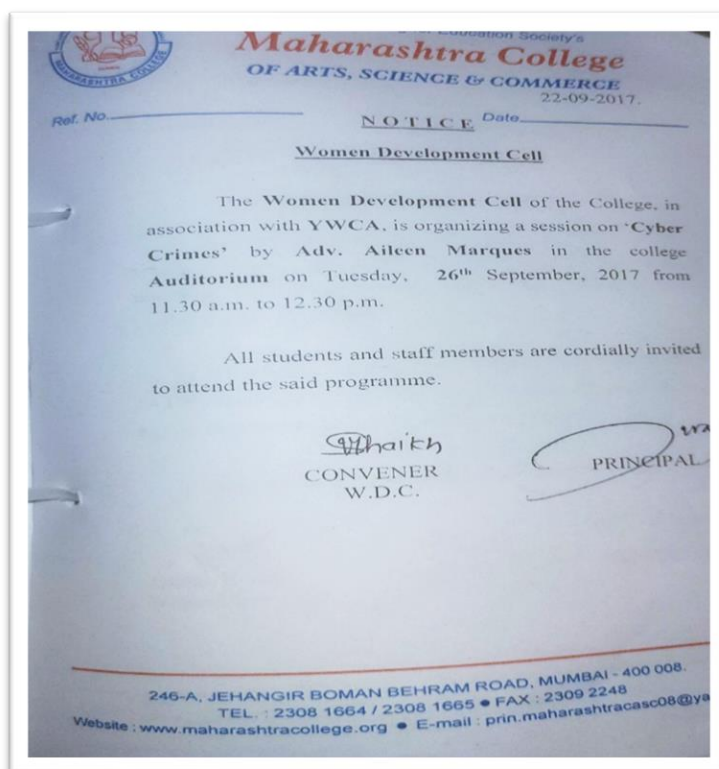
#### Women Development Cell from 2016-17 to 2018-19


Introduction :





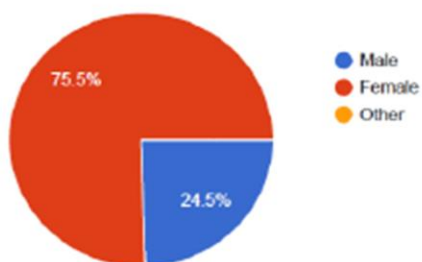
